All of us have been told we need to read the Bible but really don’t know where to start. This is the reading plan I recommend, to be followed in this sequence.

**Read at least one chapter per day and before you start and ask the Holy Spirt to give you revelation.**

1. **Genesis:** To me this is one of the most important books in the Bible because it tells how the world began and the major players.
2. **Matthew:** This first gospel that proves Jesus was the Jewish Messiah. After Matthew read the book of Acts and then read every epistle through the book of Revelations. Then read Mark and follow the same reading plan, then Luke with the same reading plan and finally John. Doing this you have read the New Testament through 4 times.
3. **Proverbs (everyday):** This book has 31 chapters and the easiest way to read it is one chapter for each day of the month.
4. **Psalms:** Start reading from beginning at least one psalm a day.
5. **Old Testament:** After you have completed the New Testament 4 times then start reading books in the Old Testament.
