LETTERS FROM HOPE FOR ALL IN JESUS MEMBERS:

Praise the Lord! This Prison Ministry team is compiled of a wonderful mix of people from a variety of cultures and backgrounds who are eager to serve the Lord. Here are some Praise reports from a couple of the visits made to Prisons during the Month of July.

Church Service held at Duncan Unit in Diboll, TX

On the 29th of July, Minister John Hammond, Bobbie Lopez and Dan Grove traveled to Diboll, Texas to hold a service at the Duncan Unit. I believe the enemy did not want this service because Dan was stopped from going in because they said his name was on the list. Also, when Bobbies and I were allowed into the church service area at 8:45am we were informed that the service is to end at 10:45am allowing plenty of time, however, the men were not released into the service until 9:45am. The prison worship team open the service and then Bobbie ushered in the Presence of God with anointed gospel songs. The message, "Get Acquainted with Your Heavenly Father" encouraged the men to understand that God is our Father and not judge. There were 75 men in the service and when the call was made to recommit their lives to developing their relationship with God, all the men stood and were enthusiastic to draw closer our Heavenly Father.

Church Service held at Joe Keagan State Jail, Houston, TX

On the 15th of July, Minister John Hammond and Dan Groves went to this unit to hold services. Inside, we learned that we would have 3 hours with the inmates of which 25 men came to the service. After a time of Praise and Worship during which we pulled some old songs out of the mothballs to Glorify the Lord. I am confident He was as blessed as we were as we raised our voices in song. John also blessed us with individual song that magnified The Lord. Dan Groves shared some of his testimony after which we were all ministered to by John on "The Location of God", His address. We all know God inhabits our praise, and John expounded more on where and how you can find the heart of God. We could use a follow up on that John. When the message was concluded, we opened up for testimonies from the inmates. We asked if any had a testimony about hearing from the Holy Spirit and obeying Him and the result. We had some stories of how the Spirit had called on them and they had followed. Then we asked if any had ever heard the Holy Spirit; but ignored Him and disobeyed. There were a few chuckles as many of them would not be in that room if they had listened to the gentle nudging of God's Holy Spirit. There were some very interesting testimonies, such as one, who had been released and ran into an acquaintance from High School who was a preacher's son and was now pastoring a church. The man invited him to come, but he did not take up the invitation and, well, here he was now. Shoulda listened. In the end, we filled those 3 hours and hardly anyone was ready to leave when the time was up. NOTE: It's not entertainment but the ministry of the Holy Spirit.

THIS ARTICLE FROM LAST MONTH NEWSLETTER BEARS REPEATING.

The Bible is <u>God's Word</u> and the only absolutely divine thing that there is upon this earth in visible, tangible form.

All of us have been told we need to read the Bible but really don't know where to start. This is the reading plan I recommend, to be followed in this sequence.

Read at least one chapter per day and before you start ask the Holy Spirt to give you revelation.

- 1. **Genesis:** To me this is one of the most important books in the Bible because it tells how the world began and the major players.
- 2. **Matthew:** This first gospel that proves Jesus was the Jewish Messiah. After Matthew read the book of Acts and then read every epistle through the book of Revelations. Then read Mark and follow the same reading plan, then Luke with the same reading plan and finally John. Doing this you have read the New Testament through 4 times.
- 3. **Proverbs (everyday):** This book has 31 chapters and the easiest way to read it is one chapter for each day of the month.
- 4. **Psalms:** Start reading from beginning at least one psalm a day.
- 5. Old Testament: After you have completed the New Testament 4 times then start reading books in the Old Testament.
