Break Every Chain is a place where if you or someone you know is suffering from addictive behavior of any kind, including: drugs, alcohol, food, gambling, pornography, sex addiction, or co-dependency issues; or simply want to fellowship with Brothers and Sisters in Christ, you can join them every Friday night for food, fellowship, praise, and worship, Biblical Wisdom, and group sessions. Their group sessions are divided into male, female and youth groups and will be led by one of the New Covenant Church leaders. Child care is provided.
