They were eager to participate and ready to give an answer of the HOPE that is in them to those around them. We prayed over several who would be released soon.

The Lord used Pastor Leonard Ventress to deliver the Word at Clemens Unit on Sunday, **September 15, 2019**, entitled “Sheep on the Right and Goats on the Left”. As usual he kept it very real and relevant to the men. In ministry he was accompanied by his wife, Pastor Cynthia. About 12 people came up for the altar call. Two gentlemen accepted Christ as Lord of their lives for the very first time. Praise God! There were several recommitments, and a couple of men were delivered. One inmate testified that he was freed from demonic oppression and mental confusion when we had prayed for him months before. He said that he is about to be released, and that this Sunday was his last in the chapel. He had prayed to see us one more time before leaving Clemens. He said that he no longer has to take medication, and no longer hears tormenting voices. This young man said that he will be searching out Hope For All in Jesus when he returns to the free world. We rejoice with him, that in Jesus he is free!
