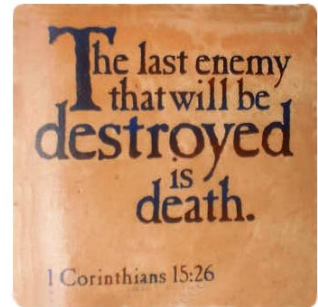
ENTER INTO THE REST OF GOD YOUR SAVIOR

During this time the ministry has seen hundreds come to the Lord, lives changed and many of the ex-offenders are now pastors. Pastor Robert and Sister Audrey were always faithful and traveled many thousands of miles to the many prisons they had been invited to. My respect goes out to Pastor Robert as he never gave up and even with serious health issues and in his eighties desired to go into the prisons to tell about the salvation of Jesus. The thing that amazed me in the last few years was when Pastor Robert went into a facility, many times he had to use a walker, however when got he up to minister the anointing would come on him and his vigor changed so that he moved and preached like he was 20 years younger. During this time of the virus Robert's desire was still to minister to people, so he had his friends help him purchase the video equipment needed so he could minister on Facebook. He has been an encouragement to the body of Christ like no one I know; I admire him and hope to follow his example.
